Many residents are questioning why the lease asks for proof of Adjusted Gross income in January when income taxes are not due until April 15. Riverton Tower Senior Center, Inc. must file for property tax exemption in March of each year. By law, all W-2s must be received no later than the end of January so we can accept proof into the early part of February. A copy of your 2018 W-2 or Social Security end-of-year statement will suffice as the needed proof.
