RTSC Updates

I met recently with Ken Jones to get an update on the RTSC.

4th Floor: Major work on the West Wing of the 4th Floor is coming to an end as the seven new apartments are nearing completion. The City of Jacksonville will have its Final Inspection around the time this issue is being read. These apartments should come on line in November.

Phase 2 renovation will then commence on the eight apartments of the 4th Floor East Wing.

Roof: Ken and Management are working hard coming to terms with Roofing Contractors.

Best Outlook is for the work to take place starting in the January-April time frame. The awning at the Front Entrance of the building will also be repaired and re-roofed. Once we have the new roof, the 12th Floor should be cooler due to the better insulation. The rain run-off (“Waterfalls”) at the front should come to an end, too!

Lobby: Soon, wallpaper in the Lobby will be removed, walls cleaned and walls painted.

Elevators: “We’re evaluating & considering estimates for completion”. Elevators are “totally safe” and “are more reliable now than they have been”. More modifications coming.

Excitement goes all around the city,

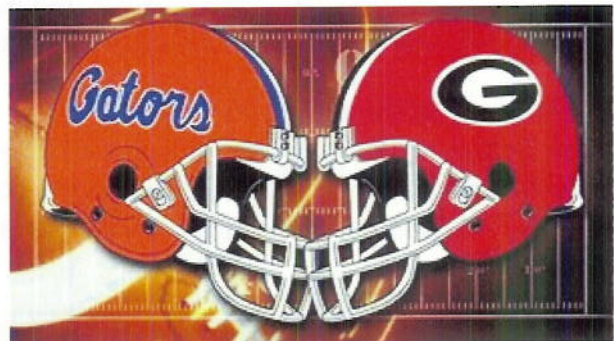
One school will win and one we will pity.
