Proof of 2021 Income

Some of you have yet to submit your 2021 income information. Under Florida law, to be eligible for real estate tax exemptions, we must have proof of all residents' income. We must collect all of your income for the year of 2021 and then complete an application that **must** be submitted to the Property Appraiser's Office on or before March 1, 2022.

After receiving your 1099s in the mail, please make haste in submitting this information to us.

We need your help to obtain this exemption.
